- › Answer general family law questions
 - › Explain the Ontario legal and court systems
 - › Explain a person's rights and obligations
 - › Direct women towards other resources such as Family Court accompaniment and support services

The legal support worker can put women in contact with a lawyer that can offer up to 4 hours of free consultation to:

- › Give clear answers in plain language to any legal questions
 - › Examine how the law applies to their personal situation
 - › Review documents and forms to be submitted to the Court
